#### **Staff Report:**

In April 2017, the Town of Zebulon Board of Commissioners adopted the most recent updates to the Zebulon Multimodal Transportation Plan. The recent increase in residential and commercial development necessitates a closer look at areas where the models used for the 2014 updates did not reflect the actual growth Zebulon is experiencing. Although the special use permits had already been approved for Weaver's Pond and Taryn Meadows, other developments such as Waffle House, Sheetz, the widening of N. Arendell, and the subdivisions of Taryn Creek, Autumn Lakes, and Barrington are increasing traffic in a pattern that was not modeled in the 2014 update. The growth along current and potential corridors compels an update to the plan with current data to ensure proper roadway improvements are required at the time of development. Network connectivity and built-in redundancies will help maintain the flow of all traffic, including pedestrians, at the volumes we are expecting due to growth.

Mark Hetrick, Planning Director, has issued a separated memo which is attached to this staff report. Mr. Hetrick discusses the recommended improvements and updates. These updates include roadway widening to include an additional lane, curb and gutter, and sidewalks.

#### **Executive Summary:**

The Planning Board and Board of Commissioners will consider revisions to the Zebulon Multimodal Transportation Plan.

#### Background:

Town of Zebulon adopted the Zebulon Multimodal Transportation Plan in April 2001. The Board of Commissioners amended the Plan in May 2014 and April 2017.

Additional Plan revisions are needed to further address new developments strain on the existing transportation system. These revisions will incorporate previous Plan amendments, provide consistency between projects, include areas not previously covered, and address intersection improvements.

#### **Policy Analysis:**

The Zebulon Multimodal Transportation Plan is a policy document establishing Zebulon's transportation goals as laid out in Zebulon's Comprehensive Plan. The proposed updates would ensure these goals are met by recognizing current and potential growth corridors, and establishing standards for future developments along these corridors to ensure appropriate infrastructure installation, right of way widths, and sidewalk connectivity.

#### Fiscal Impact:

The proposed Transportation Plan changes would require future development to make the roadway improvements along the frontage of their property.


#### **Discussion:**

The discussion before the Board is whether amending the Zebulon Multimodal Transportation Plan meets the goals laid out in the Comprehensive Plan's transportation chapter. Revisions to the Plan include replacing "Appendix A: Project Map" and "Appendix B: Project Cross Sections" in the 2035 Plan Update dated May 2014 with the attachments provided. Updating these appendices will:

- a) Create consistency between the project map, cross section configurations, and recent projects.
- b) Manage additional growth and new development pressure.
- c) Incorporate the April 3, 2017 Board of Commissioner Plan updates.
- d) Incorporate areas not previously covered under the current Plan.
- e) Reference the Zebulon Greenway, Bicycle & Pedestrian Master Plan.
- f) Expand intersection and signalization improvements.




#### 2-Lane with Sidewalk and Bicycles



This cross section configuration includes two, 14 foot lanes with curb and gutter and sidewalks on both sides of the roadway. The wide lane width could be used to accommodate bicycles. The total width from sidewalk to sidewalk is 47 feet.


#### **Rural Roadway with Wide Paved Shoulders**



This cross section consists of two, 12 foot lanes with 4 foot paved shoulders that could accommodate bike lanes on both sides of the roadway. The total width of the pavement is 32 feet.


#### **Rural Roadway with Sidewalk and Bicycles**



This cross section consists of two, 12 foot lanes with 4 foot paved shoulders that could accommodate bicycle lanes. The cross section also features a side walk on one side that is separated from the road by a ditch. The distance of separation of the side walk is variable based on speed, volume, and the slope of the ditch. The total width of the pavement is 32 feet.


#### **Downtown Transition**



This cross section consists of two, 13 foot, 6 inch lanes with shared lane markings for bicycles, 8 foot on street parking lanes, and curb and gutters on both sides of the roadway. The cross section also has sidewalks on one side of the roadway. The total width from curb to curb is 43 feet.


#### Greenway / Multi-Use Path


#### 3-Lane



This cross section includes two 14 foot lanes and a 12 foot two-way center turn lane with curb and gutters. The wide lane width could be used to accommodate bicycles. The cross section also includes sidewalks on both sides of the roadway. The length from the edge of the sidewalk to the curb and gutter is 7 foot 6 inches. The total width from sidewalk to sidewalk is 59 feet.


#### 3-Lane with Narrow 2-way Left Turn Lane



This cross section includes two 14 foot lanes and a narrow 9 foot two-way center turn lane. The wide lane width could be used to accommodate bicycles. The cross section also includes sidewalks on both sides of the roadway. The total width of the cross section from sidewalk to sidewalk is 56 feet.


#### 2-Lane Median Divided



This cross section includes two 14 foot lanes with curb and gutter, divided by a 16 foot terrain median that can support trees or other aesthetic vegetation. The wide lane width could be used to accommodate bicycles. The cross section also includes 5 foot sidewalks with 2 foot 6 inches of terrain on both sides. There are lamp posts posted along the sidewalks located within the far side terrain area. The total width of the cross section is 68 feet 2 inches.


#### **3-Lane with Ditch and Sidewalks**



This cross section includes two 12 foot lanes, a 12 foot two-way center turn lane, and 4 foot paved shoulders on both sides of the roadway that could accommodate bicycle traffic. The cross section also features sidewalks on both sides that are separated by a ditch. The distance of separation of the side walk is variable based on speed, volume, and the slope of the ditch. The total width of the paved section is 44 feet.


#### **Consistent with NC 96 Study**


#### 2-Lane with Sidewalk (Option 1)


#### 2-Lane with Sidewalk (Option 2)
