Executive Summary:

The attached financials are for Board of Commissioners review only. See discussion below for details on statements.

Background:

The attached financials are a summary of revenues and expenditures to date. These are provided to keep the Board informed, on a monthly basis, of how revenues and expenditures are trending throughout the year.

Information:

These financial statements are through November 20, 2017. We have received two month of sales tax and none of the quarterly distributions of utilities sales in FY 2018. As usual, the majority of property taxes will be received now through December. See notes below for analysis on those and other revenues.

For FY 2018, approximately 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ months in to the new year, the Town has spent about 34% (approximately \$3,741,000) of its General Fund budget of \$11,150,372. It is too early in the year to discuss trends in revenues or expenditures. Some discussion on some early revenue activity such as zoning fees and property taxes are below. The revenue and expenditure statements are included for your review.

A few highlights to date include:

Sales Tax

- Sales taxes collected in August 2017 were received and were 1.7% (\$1,376) more than the distribution received for the same period in FY 2017.
- For the first two months of FY 2018 they are 7.5% (\$11,800) ahead of FY 2017.
- Article 39 receipts, proceeds returned to the county of origin, were 1.3% (\$493) more in August than the distribution received for the same period in FY 2017.
- Article 39 totals are ahead of last year's year-to-date total for the first two months by 8.0% (\$5,752). (Ref. attached Sales Tax Collections spreadsheet).

<u>Utilities Sales Tax (Sales tax on natural gas, electricity, telecommunication services and video programming)</u>

• The first distribution for FY 2018 will not be received until December 15.



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Property Tax

- Property taxes collected so far in FY 2018 are approximately \$1,255,000. This is 21% of budgeted revenues (\$5,826,900).
- This is 7.5% more than what was collected to date in FY 2017 (\$1,168,000).

Permits & Zoning

- Permit and zoning fees collected to date in FY 2018 are \$63,968.
- This is 106% of budgeted revenues (\$60,000) for the year.
- It is about 196% more than what was collected to date in FY 2017 (\$21,611).

<u>Transportation Impact Fees</u>

- Transportation Impact fees collected to date for FY 2018 are \$44,173.
- This is 176% of budgeted revenues (\$25,000) for the year.
- It is 269% more than what was collected to date in FY 2017 (\$11,971).
- The unaudited balance to date of Transportation Impact fees is \$44,173.
- This revenue is placed into a reserve for current and future transportation projects to be spent within 10 years.

Policy Analysis: N/A

Financial Analysis: Budgeted revenue is \$11,150,372 while year to date revenue collected is \$2,360,938 (21% of budgeted). As shown in the chart on the Revenue Statement, 56% of year to date revenues come from property taxes.

Staff Recommendation:

No staff recommendation or Board action is necessary. These are informational only.


