APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Commissioner Clark made a motion, second by Commissioner Bumgarner to approve the agenda. There was no discussion and the motion passed unanimously.

SCHOOL RECOGNITION

PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD

Denise Nowell, from the Zebulon Chamber of Commerce, stated the first Zebulon After Hours for the year was January 10 at Zebulon Middle School.

A. Public Works

1. Ordinance 2019-18—PARTF Grant

Chris Ray explained the Town was awarded \$90,230 in PARTF grant funds on September 12, 2018 and asked the Board to consider appropriating the funds toward greenway construction. The funds would be used for construction of a 10' wide asphalt trail approximately 5,100 LF or .966 miles in length.

Commissioner Strickland inquired about the location of the greenway. The greenway began at Spiderlily Court in Taryn Meadows and connected to Weavers Pond.

Commissioner Bumgarner made a motion, second by Commissioner Beck to adopt Ordinance 2019-18. There was no discussion and the motion passed unanimously.

BOARD COMMENTS

Commissioner Moore and Commissioner Clark wished everyone a Happy New Year.

MANAGER'S REPORT

Family movie night was January 11 at 7:00pm and showed The Incredibles 2.


